Treatment Description:

Phase I: Restore all upper teeth to optimal appearance and function. This will consist of crowns, veneers, and onlays.

Phase II: Restore 12 lower teeth to optimal appearance and function with a combination of veneers and crowns. This plan excludes the two lower left molars, as the current restorations are serviceable and not in the cosmetic zone.

Phase I: Upper Teeth

Appointment	Treatment	Time until next appointment
1	Prepare upper teeth for cosmetic restorations Place temporary cosmetic restorations	1 week
3	Follow up to reshape temporary restorations	3 weeks
4	Place final restorations	1 week
5	Follow up, adjust bite*	N/A

*May need to adjust lower teeth to balance bite

Phase II: Lower Teeth

Appointment	Treatment	Time until next appointment
1	Prepare lower teeth for cosmetic restorations Place temporary cosmetic restorations	1 week
3	Follow up to reshape temporary restorations	3 weeks
4	Place final restorations	1 week
5	Follow up, adjust bite	N/A

As per our discussion, other treatment options include:

- No treatment
- Limited restorative care as indicated for broken or decayed teeth

As with any dental treatment, there may be unforeseen complications. We will make an effort to anticipate any changes in the treatment plan and advise you at that time. For example, the possibility exists, in your case, that some teeth may require root canal therapy in the course of this treatment. Such events are unpredictable. Likewise, the timing or spacing of appointments

may need to be modified as needed to accomplish the best result possible. We will make every effort to accommodate your scheduling needs.

While dental treatment such as this may last for many years, we cannot make any guarantees as it pertains to longevity. It is possible you will need further treatment or retreatment in the future. For example, root canals done in the past may fail. Other teeth may require root canal treatment after the restorations are placed. Teeth that are crowned can develop decay where the tooth and crown meet.

Continuing professional preventive care and meticulous home care will be critical to maintaining your reconstruction for as long as possible. I recommend getting your teeth cleaned every 3 months after your reconstruction.

This level of treatment is complex and time consuming. Your first restorative visit will be several hours. You will be the doctor's only patient during that time, so you will have our undivided attention. Accordingly, making it to your appointment as scheduled is very important.
